Trevor Romain is a best-selling author and illustrator of an award-winning series of self-help books for children, as well as a sought-after motivational speaker. Trevor and his animated friends hosted a popular television series on PBS. The series uses humorous adventures based on his books to teach real-life lessons for kids, such as dealing with bullies, facing fears, and understanding grief. The series has won numerous awards. Trevor's books have sold more than a million copies worldwide and have been published in 16 different languages.

For more than 20 years, Trevor has traveled to schools, hospitals, summer camps, and military bases worldwide, delivering stand-up comedy with self-help messages to hundreds of thousands of school-age children. He has been the keynote speaker at numerous education and mental health conferences around the world and has appeared regularly on national media outlets.

Trevor is known for his work as president of the American Childhood Cancer Organization, as well as his work with the Make-A-Wish Foundation, The United Nations, UNICEF, USO, The Trevor Romain Company, and the Trevor Romain Foundation. He has performed for multiple USO tours, giving military kids a new way to look at deployment and parents who return injured. The United Nations also enlisted Trevor's help in developing educational materials for children living in armed conflict areas. Trevor Romain's commitment to children is profound and consistent.

- In partnership with the USO and DOD, released the *With You All the Way! Deployment Kit*. The kit includes resources that help and comfort military children and their families. By the end of 2010, over 20,000 children will have received these kits.
- In partnership with the USO and DOD, development of new resources to help children of wounded soldiers, Winter 2011
- The With You All the Way Program is a comedy-based educational USO tour. Visiting bases across the country and the world, the tour is designed to entertain kids while giving them strategies to cope with military life, 2010-2011
